	Early Access Training Modules	A task team of higher ed and community college faculty as well as Early ACCESS liaisons and providers designed the Foundations of Early Intervention online module (foundations.earlyaccessstraining.com). The module was designed to provide students with foundational information prior to doing any type of field experience in early intervention (e.g. shadowing, practicum, student teaching), but any early childhood student can benefit from the information in the modules. The module can be used by students in its entirety (with built in activities, quizzes, and a certificate of completion) or

The videos range from a couple of minutes to 35 minutes, and include interviews with families, clips of Early ACCESS providers coaching families, and reflections from providers.</p>
