The Campaign seeks to : Raise awareness of the importance of voting to social work practice and impact; Integrate voter engagement activities into class and field education for all social work students (micro and macro); Provide information about voter mobilization skills and strategies to field instructors, students and faculty for use in agencies and the classroom; and Ensure that all the people served by social workers have access to the vote. Social workers have understood the importance of voting to political action, community power and social justice dating back the Settlement House movement.
