MENTAL HEALTH COMMUNITY ADVOCATES



The Community Adult Mental Health Initiative (CAMHI) is looking for individuals who have been involved in the mental health system and are interested in being a part of CAMHI by filling the roles of a Community Advocate. We currently have **SIX** total positions open that we hope to fill ASAP! The following counties are all in need of Community Advocate representation:

- Benton County (1)
- Sherburne County (2)
- Stearns County (1)
- Wright County (2)

Eligibility:

- A) Individual has a diagnosed serious and persistent mental illness (SPMI); OR
- B) Is an immediate family member of an individual experiencing SPMI who is unable to participate as a Community Advocate due to their illness; and
- C) The individual is a resident* of Benton, Sherburne, Stearns or Wright County

Duties include attending and participating in the CAMHI Advisory Committee meetings. Meetings are held six times a year on the first Thursday of the even-numbered months (February, April, June, August, October, and December) from 1 to 3pm, with a rotating schedule for the location. All Advisory meetings will have an online option to join. Participation in CAMHI's sub-committees are encouraged, but not required. Advocates will receive a stipend and mileage reimbursement for attending the CAMHI meetings.
