Rebecca Kotz is an advocate, writer, and educator on various forms of men's violence. She currently counsels and advocates for survivors of the sex trade, is a trainer and consultant for professionals, and educates community members on healthy relationships, men's violence against women, culture and media literacy, harms of pornography, and abuse prevention. Ms. Kotz co-founded an outreach to women in local strip clubs and developed the first program for exploited and trafficked women in Central MN. She also developed and facilitates the court-ordered education/accountability John School for men who have been convicted of soliciting commercial sex.
