Get Counted

PIT (Point In Time)



is a count of all people experiencing homelessness nationwide on one single night in January annually. It is a short, anonymous survey that can be done for up to one week after making sure we are all asking where they stayed the night of January 24th.

The PIT Count is important because:

- It lets community leaders know the needs of people experiencing homelessness
- It helps state leaders create plans to prevent and end homelessness
- It could get more money for programs and affordable housing options
