This session will address the unique legal and behavioral aspects of working with dementia and how it both differs from mental illness and may overlap. Along with an overview of guardianship, commitment, and the roles of each, the session will offer strategies for managing challenging behavioral expressions and advocating for underserved clients with cognitive impairments or other barriers to inclusive care.

By the end of the session, participants will be able to:

- Identify common warning signs and behavioral expressions in dementia.
- Describe the difference between guardianship and commitment and the role of each.
- Discuss how mental illness and dementia may co-exist yet differ.
