The Annual PIT (Point In Time)

is a count of people experiencing homelessness across the US on a single night-January 25. A short, anonymous survey is done for up to one week after Jan. 25.

The PIT Count is important because:

- It lets community leaders know the needs of people experiencing homelessness
- It helps state leaders create plans to prevent and end homelessness
- It could get more money for programs and affordable housing options
