 Tim will be presenting on the Continuums of Care (CoC), a regional strategic planning body to plan and implement housing and services to reduce the incidence of homelessness by assisting individuals, youth and families experiencing homelessness to access services and stable housing.

 Brenda will be presenting on Coordinated Entry System, a process that assesses and matches eligible households to housing opportunities. Housing opportunities include rapid re-housing, transitional housing, and permanent supportive housing.
