Class #1:

Gray Matters: Mental Illness Co-Occurring with Dementia

Training will:

- Describe mental illness basics in adults
- Describe dementia basics in older adults
- Identify the risk factors and warning signs of key mental illnesses and dementia in older adults
- Bring an understanding to treatment, management and recovery
- Discuss strategies for working with someone living with the two disorders
- Provide resources for older adults living with the co-occurring disorders of mental illness and dementia

Class #2:

QPR Training (Suicide Prevention)

Attendees will:

- Acquire skills for identifying the warning signs of suicide and responding appropriately and quickly
- Identify crisis resources in the area and learn how and when to access them
- Achieve a greater understanding of means restriction and its relationship to completed suicide
- Learn various options for restricting access to firearms and other lethal means

A Certificate of Attendance for each training will be provided for Board of Social Work CEUs
