

## Thriving with Layered Identity: Mental Health and Suicide in the LGBTQ+\* Community Presentation by: Nate Cannon

Nate holds a BA in Sociology of Law, Criminology and Deviance from the University of Minnesota, a Paralegal certificate, and Master of Fine Arts in Creative Writing from Hamline University. He is an award winning, nationally recognized public speaker, trainer, and author. A fierce advocate for transgender rights, mental health awareness, and neurological health issues, he is 15 years sober and has completed 15 marathons since 2009 despite the onset of acquired dystonia, a painful and challenging neurological disorder. He speaks regularly to educators, law enforcement, health care providers, and the public regarding his experiences being transgender and in recovery, living with both mental illness and a physical disability resulting from a suicide attempt.
